What's in it for you?

Along with industry insight, you will gain hands-on experience in the Union's Events and Marketing Department.

The Programme will include the following opportunities:

- Gain real industry experience and professional development in areas of event and project management, marketing and communications, programming, budgeting and stakeholder management.
- Learn new skills through the programme's series of industry-based workshops
- Help structure and deliver high profile events such as *O'Week* and gain back-end insight.
- Receive one-on-one mentoring sessions with members of the Union's Events and Marketing departments.
- Gain opportunities to build industry networks and relationships
- Access to training sessions and opportunities in your areas of interest.

Selection Criteria

Candidates must:

- Be a student at the University of Adelaide and be a member of the Union in 2018
- Demonstrate a strong involvement with the University community and the student experience.
- Commit to the Union's Student Experience Director program for a ten month period, attend fortnightly meetings for a 2 hour period and assist with relevant events.
- Actively participate in activities, meet deadlines, operate in a professional manner and prioritise student experience throughout your involvement.
- Be a fun, outgoing and energetic individual who is ready for a challenge.

Expectations and Responsibilities

This role represents a large commitment and involves working on large events, such as *O'Week*, where planning occurs over the summer break. We expect a 90% attendance rate for the programme.

As a Student Experience Director you will:

- Play an important role in the delivery of *O'Week*.
- Be available to start in mid-November and able to commit to a minimum of 4-6 hours per fortnight until completion of the *O'Week* event.
- Be available to meet at least once a fortnight for the duration of the programme, and not absent for extended periods due to travel or work commitments.
- Be available for extensive periods of time for the fortnight preceding *O'Week* and be available for the entire duration of this events including setup and pack down of each day.
- Be able to work independently on specific projects with basic levels of support and guidance.

Selection Process:

Candidates must be a member of the Union or sign up as a member in 2018. The online application form closes **5:00PM MONDAY the 30th of OCTOBER 2017**. An informal interview will follow if required.
